This SFR equipment has a heavy-duty Dressta steel drum along with a winch line attachment with brackets attached to the drum. There is a tensioning apparatus that prevents the line from coming into contact with the slope face. A cleaning system and precision guide are part of the machine. Fire Tractor Dozers The Dressta fire tractor dozers are an excellent defense in forest fire work in terms of prevention, containment and cleaning up forest fires. These fire dozers are commonly employed in difficult work environments such as working with falling trees, dirt, airborne sand and heavy ash. Firefighting crews use these machines for removing combustible debris, clearing fire lines and making paths. Fire suppression equipment includes external sensors, nozzles and an onboard control unit. Operator and machine safety is further enhanced by metallic fire curtains, sweeps, mesh and steel screen and guards to help prevent damage in this dangerous work environment. The electrical components inside the tractor are protected by fire-resistant sheeting, while heavy-duty guards protect hoses and hydraulic cylinders. Winches, fire plows and bush blades comprise some of the additional attachments to

tackle fires. A direct drive powertrain prevents overheating along with cooling modules for the charge air, powertrain and radiator. Belt Shifting Mining operations utilize conveyor belts to transport minerals and debris from the seam to reprocessing locations. The Dressta model SB-85 is useful for realigning and repositioning conveyor belts. This machine is commonly used in confined spaces and can be used to shift railway tracks. It features high ground clearance making it useful for difficult terrain and features a 2500mm belt width.
