A lever is responsible for steering the pallet jack and it additionally functions as a pump handle capable of raising the jack. A small handle located on the tiller allows the forks to be lowered to the ground. Hydraulic fluid is discharged when the handle is activated. There are front wheels located inside the end of the forks which are mounted on levers. The pallet jack cylinder unites with linkage levers that are attached to the fork levers. The hydraulic jack raises at the end with this system as the links force the wheels down. Raised vertically above the front wheels, the forks only travel high enough to clear the floor to maintain safety. Usually, pallet jacks have steering wheels located at the front of the machine, while each fork is equipped with a single or double wheel design.
